Course content	<p>The Masters thesis links planning and research work with a central theme: the town. Work is carried out independently. The candidate is responsible for the issues addressed in the thesis, as well as for its progress and for organisation of the group of evaluators.</p>
Course aims, competencies	<p>The ability to deepen and develop a strategic architectural topic. Preparing a Masters thesis involves formulating and realising a complex architectural project: carrying out an analysis, developing a planning project and its relationship to research, presenting and communicating results and creating a file on the Masters thesis. This modules develops professional, methodological and social skills, as well as furthering the student's autonomy.</p>
